Hello, everyone! Welcome back to Summer Term 2 in Cedar Class! I am so excited to be embarking on the last academic term with a fantastic group of learners! This term our topic is "Animal Magic". We will be learning this through "The Rainbow Fish" story, sensory activities and the learning about habitats and food chains in Science. Maths

In Maths we will be embedding our knowledge of place value before exploring multiplication and division. We always use resources and manipulatives to ensure mathematics is purposeful to your child's learning goals.

English

The first part of this half term, we are exploring The Rainbow Fish. This story explores issues around kindness and sharing. Towards the end of the half term, we then begin to explore animal fact files.

PSHE

Our topic this half term "Health and Wellbeing". We delve into emotional regulation, exercise and healthy eating to help support your child's knowledge of how to look after their mental and physical selves.

PE

This term we will be focusing on running and jumping. We will be using changes in speed, height and direction to develop these skills. These will be implemented into our sports day activities on 19th June.

History: In History we look at past explorer, Charles Darwin and how he recorded his research about animals and evolution. We also make comparisons between significant people in animal conservation now, such as David Attenborough.
