Theme for the term

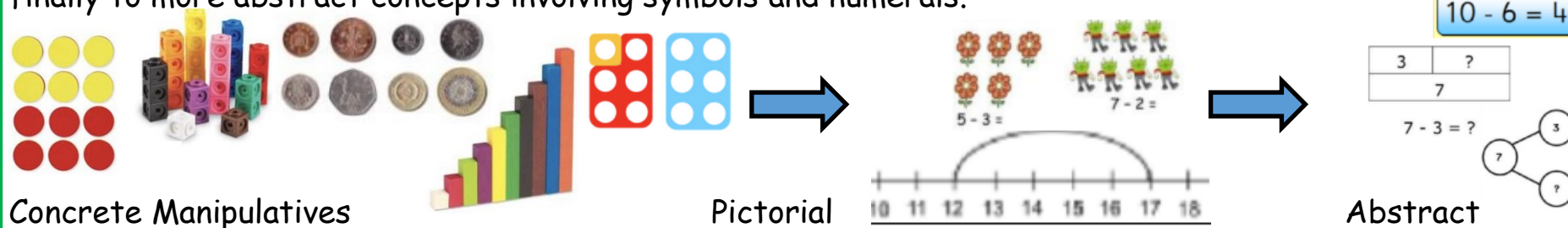
Our theme for this term is Our Local Area. We are planning to get out and about in our local community visiting places of work and learning about the jobs that people do.

Key texts

We will be reading and writing notes, messages, emails, leaflets, forms, instructions and reviews using real-life texts in our community.

HOW WE TEACH MATHS

In our Discovery (Ready to Learn) classes, we broadly follow the National Curriculum in a spiral design. We aim to embed mastery of each concept, skill and outcome before progressing to the next step. Our Maths sessions are focussed around the main skills and understanding of Number, Shape and Space, Measures and Handling Data. Maths is all around us so we aim to develop functional skills so that our learners are more confident to recognise and use maths in their everyday lives. We carefully select resources to introduce, practise and embed key concepts, and our learners will move from using physical equipment, to picture representations and finally to more abstract concepts involving symbols and numerals.
