

Celebrating Redwood class!



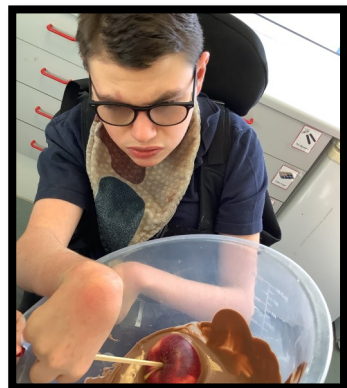

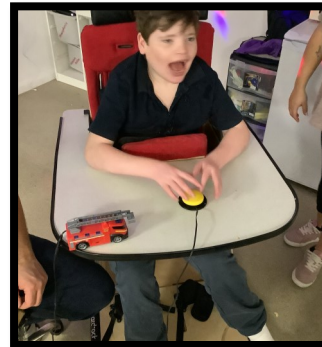
OUR CREATIVE ARTS
