

# Celebrating Apple Class!

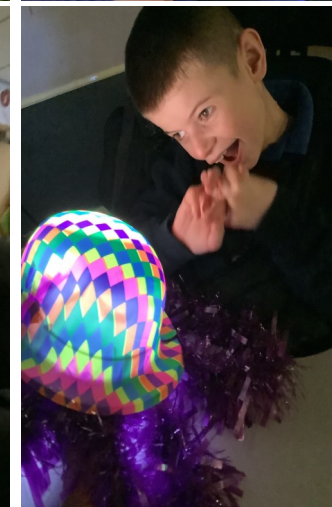
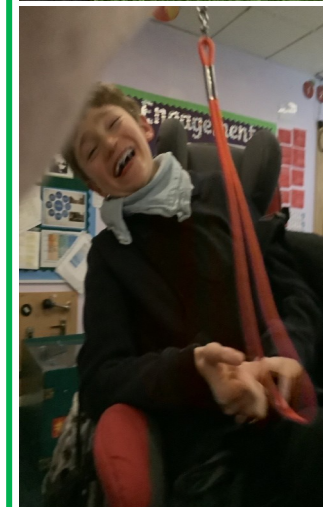
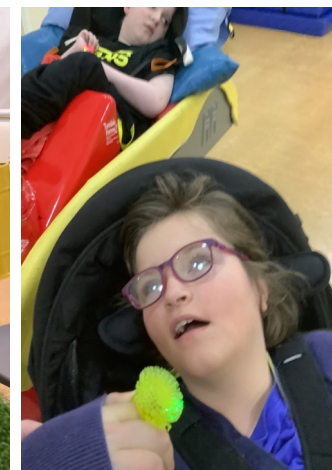
