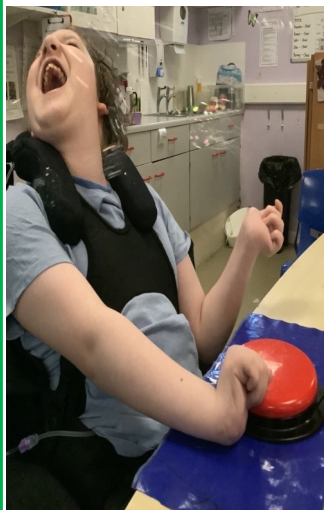
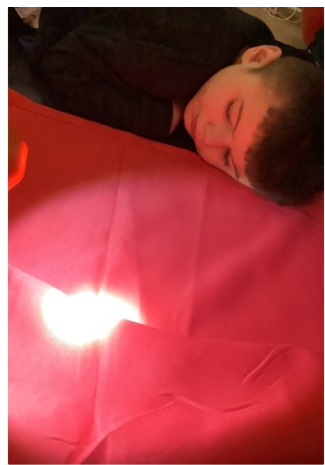


Celebrating Apple Class!
