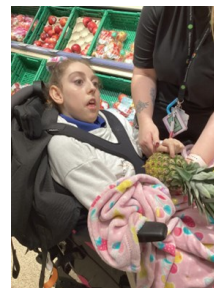
DEVELOPING OUR SKILLS
