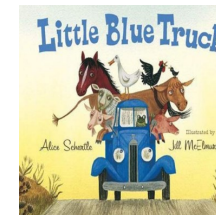
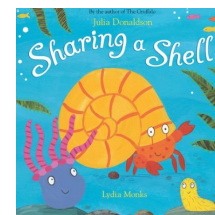

Hello and a warm welcome back to Juniper Class! We hope you had a wonderful Easter break and are ready for the Summer Term!

We will be accessing lots of learning outdoors, including plenty of water play. Please ensure there are spare clothes, waterproofs and wellies in school in readiness for lots of exploring outdoors!

FOCUS SESSION: Continuous Provision

Continuous provision is the carefully planned environment that children can access every day in early years settings (like nursery or Reception). It includes the resources, activities, and areas that are always available for children to explore—such as sand, water, role play, construction, books, creative materials, and outdoor play. These areas stay consistent so children can return to them, repeat activities, and build confidence. Teachers then enhance these areas with new resources or challenges based on children's interests and learning needs.

Why Is Continuous Provision Important?

- **Supports independence:** Children choose where to go and what to explore.
- **Encourages curiosity and problem-solving:** They learn through hands-on, self-directed play.
- **Builds key skills:** From language and maths to social skills and creativity.
- **Allows teachers to observe learning:** Staff can step in to support, extend thinking, or introduce new ideas at the right moments.
