Maths

This half term in maths we will be focusing on using equipment to add and subtract numbers.

We will then be moving onto learning all about money and the value of different coins and notes.

English

As we continue to explore the Tudors this half term we will be looking at non-fiction books to find out what life was like in Tudor times. We will then use this information to make our own Tudor information

PSHE

Our topic for PSHE is continuing with 'Health and well-being'. We will be identifying dangers in the home and in our community and recognise how to keep ourselves safe.

PE

During our swimming lessons, we will begin to learn new skills to help us move through the water.

Our PE lessons this half term will focus on gymnastics.

We will begin to understand how to use our bodies to perform basic balances.

RE: In RE this term we will continue to learn about a variety of religions, looking closely at their buildings and statues. Towards the end of the half term we will be looking at the Christmas story and the characters within the story.

RSE: In our RSE lessons we will be focussing on looking at using appropriate vocabulary to describe how our body is changing.
