 Maths Our three core areas of maths are: Number Measure, Shape and Space Data handling This term the focus is Number and Measure. In Number we are working on number systems and calculations and in Measure we will be working on developing skills in money, and time. These are taught according each learners' Accreditations Pathway. <u>RE</u> —This half term we are developing skills related to Belonging to a Religious Community'. We will look at several of the Festive Religious events and celebrations that occur at this time of year including Diwali. We will be learning about belonging to the community on the Isle of Iona and the celebration of St Nicholas Day in Germany.		<u>Active Citizenship</u> — All of our learners will have opportunities to engage in Active Citizenship learning, across the school, and / or within Post 14. For some this will come in the form of Work Experience with a variety of school staff.
