We will continue to work on our independence skills and personal care routines. Using our communication skills to build meaningful relationships with the people who help us, and continuing to learn about ourselves and our communities.

Sensory/Physical

Therapy plans form an integral part of our day. We will focus on movement, body awareness and postural management. Our lessons will involve exploration using our bodies to complete both fine and gross motor tasks. We will also be swimming and playing team games together.

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
