This half term our topic will be **Travel and Transport**. We will be exploring stimuli linked to a range of different methods of transport such as cars, trains and boats.

Cognition & Learning

Our focus will be developing anticipation and exploring cause and effect through switch work and exploring noise making and vibrating props.

Communication & Interaction

'Bucket Time' and our 'Kayaking' Sensory Story by Joanna Grace, will provide opportunities to use our senses to explore a variety of props as well as showing responses, developing preferences, anticipating, choice making and requesting 'more'.

SEMH

We will be focussing on relationships this term and will be engaging in activities which help us build meaningful relationships. Intensive Interaction and HOP (Hanging Out Programme) are great ways to do this.

Sensory Physical

To continue to work towards our therapy targets, we will use personal physiotherapy equipment in class and in the Sensory Integration Room. We will also be practising our choice making through transferring our gaze or reaching for desired items and objects.

RE

Our RE focus question this half term 'What is it like inside a religious building?'. We will be exploring special items linked to churches.


RSE
