Welcome Back to Rowan Class



Hello, everyone! Welcome back to another half term in Rowan Class!

We hope you all had a lovely Christmas and are ready for another busy half term!

Term: Spring 1 2023 This half term our topic will be **Travel and Transport**, with a Jamaican twist! We will be exploring stimuli linked to a range of different methods of transport such as cars, trains and boats.

<u>Maths</u>

This half term we will be exploring temperature by investigating hot and cold stimuli and responding to what we can feel. We will also be looking at money. We will start by exploring coins through touch, then onto grouping and sorting according to colour and size. In English, we will also be looking at the Jamaican folktale of 'Anansi and the pot of beans' and using symbols and key words to make predictions about the tale, describing main characters and settings and sequencing the story using pictures.

English

We will also be looking at poetry linked to different transport and joining in with repeated actions and phrases using a 'big mack' button.

<u>RSE</u>

Our focus will be on emotions, feelings and worries. We will start the term by identifying different feelings and sharing some worries that we may have, as well as our likes and dislikes. We will then look at a variety of different ways on how we can reduce these feelings to help us relax. Some learners will also be learning how our bodies begin to change as we get older.

<u>PE</u>

This term we will be weaving a Jamaican theme into our dance lessons by listening and responding to Calypso music! This will help us to move in a range of ways showing good control, technique and balance. We will also be developing our own dance, by combining four movements and linking them together.


<u>PSHE</u>

Our topic this half term is 'Relationships'. We will be identifying family members and friends and exploring what makes a good friend. We will be asking you to send in some family photos in the next few weeks to help learners engage in these activities.

<u>RE</u>

Our RE focus question this half term is 'What do signs and symbols mean?'. We will be exploring special symbols in different faiths and religions including light, water, food, clothes, sound and colours.
