Come to Cedar Class Hello, everyone! Welcome back to another half term in Cedar Class!

Term:

Spring 2

This half term our topic continues to be 'Travel & Transport'. We will be focusing on forces in Science by exploring and experiencing pushes and pulls, including the use of magnets. In English, our work will have a 'People Who Help Us' focus to link with our upcoming World Book Day theme. We are also focussing on the work of Van Gogh in Art, looking at his paintings 'Starry Night' and 'Sunflowers' which will lead to us creating some art work for a whole-school art exhibition at the end of March.

<u>Maths</u>

This half term we will be learning about length, weight and capacity by engaging in a variety of practical activities using a range of resources. We will also continue to work on our number, counting and place value skills.

<u>English</u>

We will be using non-fiction books and real-life objects to find out about a range of people who help us such as police, firefighters and doctors/nurses. We will then have a go at using symbols and writing sentences to create our own fact files about them.

<u>PSHE</u>

Our topic this half term continues to be 'Relationships'. We will be engaging in activities with our peers and familiar staff and begin to look at a range of different family structures. We will also be exploring what 'good' touch feels like.

<u>PE</u>

This term we will be engaging in dance by exploring different movements and shapes that our bodies can make and begin to move to the beat of music.

<u>**RE:</u>** Our RE focus question this half term continues to be 'Why do people go on journeys to sacred places?'. We will be exploring a range of sacred places in different religions.</u> <u>**RSE</u>**: Our focus will be on recognise responding to 'touch' by showing preference to different textures, practising the skill of negation if you don't like something.</u>
