Cognition & Learning

Communication & Interaction

Sensory Music, Art, Bucket Time and our 'Sheldon Snail' Sensory Story provide opportunities to use all our senses to explore, show responses, develop preferences, anticipate, choice make and request 'more'.

We will be spending time outside in the natural environment and developing our curiosity in nature. We will continue to build meaningful relationships through Intensive Interaction and HOP time where we spend quality time together.

Sensory Physical

To continue to work towards our therapy targets, we will use personal physiotherapy equipment in class and in the Sensory Integration Room. We will also be practising our choice making through transferring our gaze or reaching for desired items and objects.
