

## Post 14 Pathways and Accreditations Map

At Doubletrees we believe all of our learners should have the chance to achieve maximum success, relative to their needs, progress and aspirations. For this reason, in Year 9 – during EHCP annual reviews – we agree a qualifications pathway appropriate to their expected journey when they move beyond Doubletrees.



In Post 14 our learners engage with accreditation pathways appropriate to their individual start points.

Those working at and towards Entry Level 1 will access the ASDAN Personal Progress Accreditation as part of our Preparing for Adulthood Curriculum Offer developing skills in the four areas:

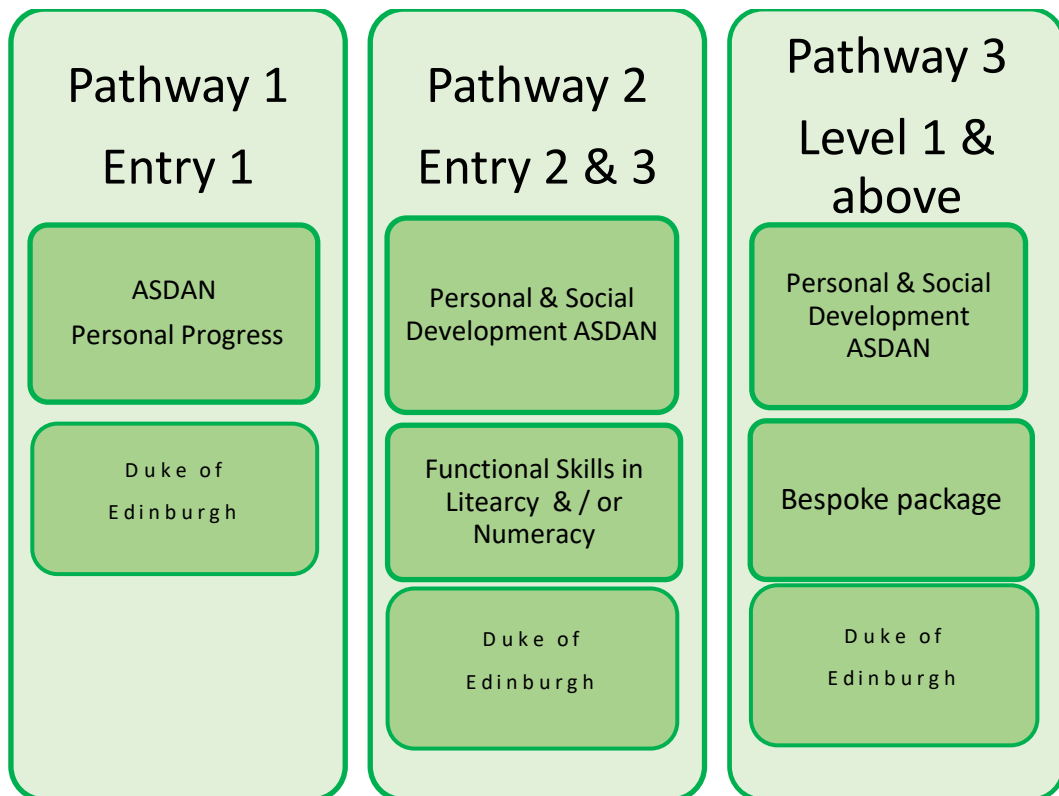
- Employment, education and training
- Independent living
- Health
- Participation in Society

Those working at Entry Level 2 and above access the Personal and Social Development ASDAN to support them with their Preparing for Adulthood needs.

Furthermore, for those who are working at Entry Level 2 and 3 in literacy and / or numeracy will work towards Functional Skills accreditations in English and Maths:

- Edexcel Functional Skills English Entry Level 2 / 3
- Edexcel Functional Skills Maths Entry Level 2 / 3

Those learners who are working beyond Entry Level 3 will access a bespoke package of accreditations appropriate to their individual potentials.
