#### School Improvement

We will shortly be sending home with a covering letter, our new Home, School and Community Passports. These have been designed to link your child/young person's personal development opportunities at school, at home and in the community. Your child/young person will receive a booklet which will be used between our school and home to record experiences and achievements. All the activities will be accessible through the Evidence for Learning App/portal, if you would like to contribute photographs and tick off activities. We will collect and monitor passports on a half termly basis and learners will have the opportunity to earn award badges for completing some or all of the tasks. There are different passports for each key stage and learning phase, so the tasks will be age appropriate and relevant to your child's developmental stage.
